A lover of time travel, Vikings, magic and heady romance, I bit on a daily deal for the set of 3 from Book Bub for free. And I was not disappointed. I give it 4.5 stars because I think the Vikings seem a little "modern" in their speech patterns but then again, these people all seem to be accustomed to time travelers in their midsts. And translation is made handy by possession of the stones. If you are not familiar with ancient Norse culture pay a visit to the History Channel's spectacular series Vikings, going on its 5th season, and get a picture in your mind. I felt the author stayed true to history. Immediately upon completion I went directly to purchase The MacLomain Series-Early Years and The MacLomain series, 3 books and 4 books respectively. Should keep me busy for a week or so. I thank all the authors out there who offer an entire series such as this for free or 99 cents, that new readers such as myself can discover their work. It pays off big time I think. I can list several of my favorite series and authors who I discovered by reading a free or 99 cent one day offering.
