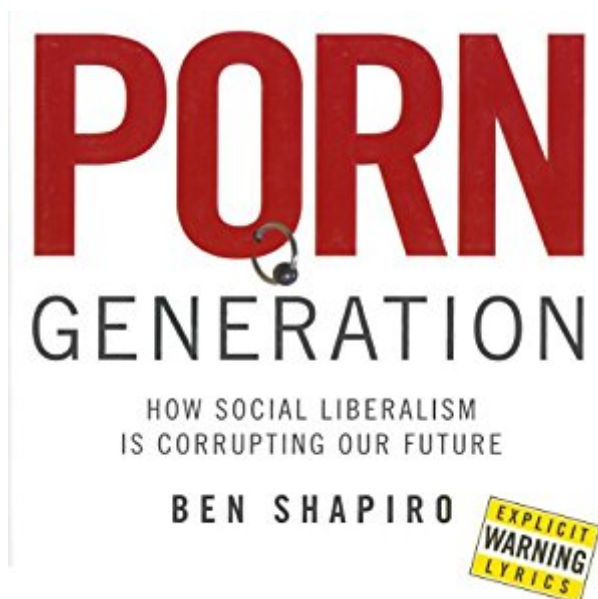


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Porn Generation: How Social Liberalism Is Corrupting Our Future

This is a very well researched and well written book by Ben Shapiro, who was only 21 at the time he wrote the book. The purpose of this book is to document all of the ways in which our country's obsession with sexual hedonism is pervasive in the media, TV, movies, books, education, and all other everyday aspects of life. Secondly the book demonstrates why this is bad for society, but the main purpose is to show that there is indeed a problem. I think this fact was missed by many of the negative reviews of the book. My guess is that Shapiro did not write this book with the intention of changing people's minds, but of showing them how ingrained an unhealthy obsession with sex is in our culture. From that point of view, the book does an incredible job. A good example of this is the chapter on teeny-boppers, who go from innocent young girls into all out sex icons. Shapiro shows that there is a similar trend in the stories of people like Spears, Agularia, Lohen, and others. As I mentioned above, it is very well documented and researched. Facts aren't simply stated without evidence. There are many personal stories and interviews that the author conducted at Harvard and other schools, making the book more "down to earth." The book is also very humorous and clever. It is clear that even if one does not agree with Shapiro's beliefs, he is an extremely talented and brilliant young man.

I purchased the audio book on audible, so not sure if my review will show up as verified purchase,

but it should. Ben proposes a lot of clinical stats and arguments...just enough to scare the hell out of parents everywhere. However, in my opinion, this battle against moral relativism cannot be fought solely in the public forum. It can only be won in each household at a time. It began with the barrenness of love and emotional development in the home, and that's where the recovery has to begin. It's easy to point the finger at single motherhood (just one example cited in the book) as the reason for some of increase in crimes in our society. However, perhaps this wouldn't have happened had the government not first intervened with 'New Deal' initiatives that basically blew up families. Also, let's not whitewash the days of old. Yes, there were moral standards for the society, but plenty of people held lower or no standards in the privacy of their own homes. This was done often to the detriment of the children growing up in those homes. This kind of conflict with inner morality vs outward societal expectations never stands the test of time. All you end up with are angry young people with an agenda to buck the 'system.' Honestly, do you think people would have paid ANY attention to Kinsey had they been mature enough to call a fool a fool? The spouting of all of the statistics and examples of degrading human behavior cited in this book doesn't do much to alleviate concerns about WHAT TO DO TO TURN THE TIDE. Abnormal sexual activity is just a result of foundational ills. Lack of knowledge of the foundations of what makes for a happy society is missing in our country. Sadly enough, I don't think the average citizen is made aware of some of the ideas being propagated to children at such young ages. It saddens me, but I think to give up on future generations is to give up on humanity. That's a difficult thing to do. One thing I think Shapiro has that is spot on is the reason for the lack of teaching of abstinence in these sexual training courses (I dare not call them sexual education courses, because listing all the various sexual acts one may partake in is not education), which is M-O-N-E-Y! Yes indeed..sex does sell, however, not in the way people think. These trainers are getting paid big bucks for bogus research studies and training courses, so do not even think they will cut their well water off for the betterment of what's most precious to any society...its children. We as a society are going to have to accept and promote the joys of authentic family life. That has to begin with each individual accepting and living the joys of being authentically human...flawed though we may be. Even with flaws, it doesn't take a genius to see, many things promoted today are just way off course and honestly, I don't think will stand the test of time.

Most of the negative comments on this book are just like those english teachers that give you a "D" or "F" because they disagree with your opinions. Unfortunately, many don't address the book for how it's written and how the material is presented. Shapiro presents well shaped arguments against

Shapiro wants to inform his readers that beyond the glitz, glamour and riches of the porn industry, there is a very dark side. Personally, I think he does a pretty good job of it. Agree or disagree, his points are shared by many people, and should at least be fairly considered by any who are interested in the debate over the spread of pornography in our society.

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
