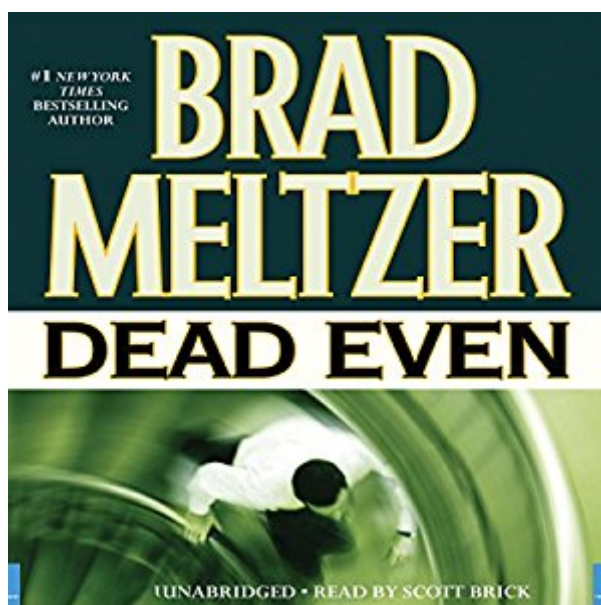

Characters seemed a bit over dramatic at times, but it did have realistic interaction. Lots of suspense and plot twists kept the pace going and the readers turning the pages.

Yes, I enjoyed that read. With Meltzer's writing, one tends to identify with almost all the individuals depicted, from the villains to the stars, from the once mentioned pedestrian to the President. The hours of leg work and study that Metzer invests before he gives us the final product are quite outstanding. I'm looking forward to his latest book, which - I understand - was released this month. I've read a number of this author's stories, and this is definitely the darkest so far. A married couple is manipulated to the point that they separate. Good people get killed. It's not a fun book to read. Engaging, perhaps, but not what I'd call enjoyable.

This was his second book. His character development is quite good . I read his books in order and I think this, being his second book was far better than his first.I would recommend Meltzer books as good reads and look forward to reading more of his works.

This was a good story, but you do have to suspend reality a bit to enjoy the plot line. Being in law enforcement I was a bit too critical of the stretches. That being said, I did enjoy the read. The story does a great job of keeping the reader entertained and considering the possibilities if you two were faced with the same circumstances. I believe, that was probably the best part of this book, was placing yourself in the shoes of the lead characters and considering what would you do if you are facing the same life-changing event?
