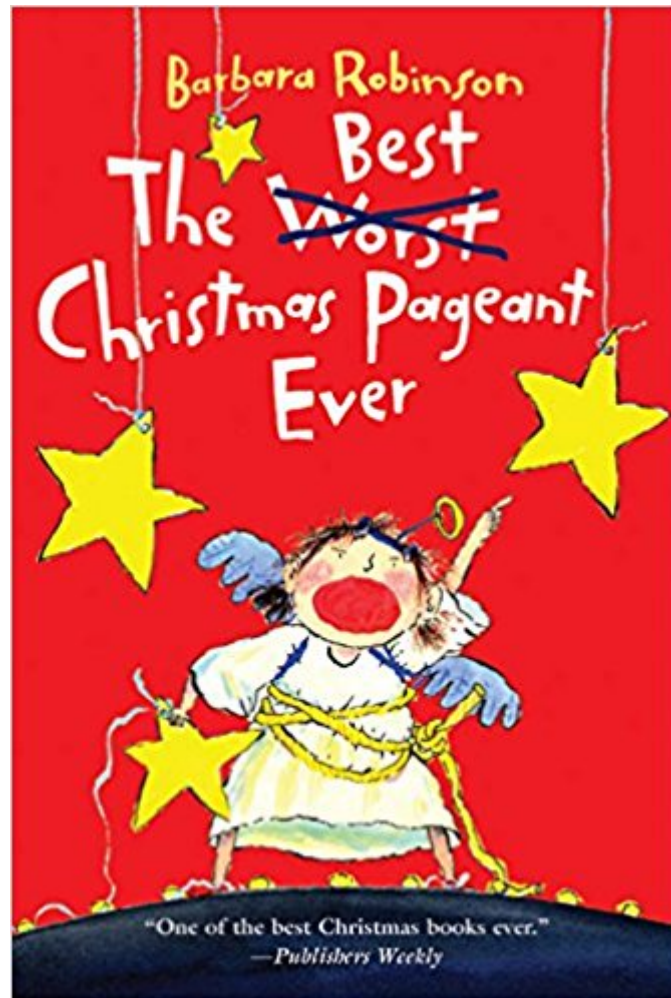

I was sitting in class (seminary) one day and we were discussing the angle of the Lord. I couldn't help but shout out, SHAZAM! People around me looked like I was nuts, until I explained that it was from a great children's book. Since then, I have had to buy a couple copies to give to friends- for them to read, enjoy, and give away or read to the children in their lives. The theology isn't perfect but when is a child's theology perfect? It is interesting to see Christmas to children who have never heard of the story/birth of Jesus. There are things that I too wondered as a kid but was too afraid to ask. Great book to use as discussion about many topics with kids and not just about religion. With so much talk about bullying, this book can lead to many open discussions about the bullies in our lives.

This book has been out for years and I still reread it every few years. It's told from the prospective of a young girl, about 10 or 12 years old. Her church has a busybody who runs everything. When the woman gets hurt, they farm out all the things she's got going (the Potluck Supper, etc) to various other ladies. The mother of the girl who's telling the story gets stuck with the Christmas Pageant. Things are going as usual until the Herdmans show up. The Herdmans are the worst kids in the whole history of the world. Things go downhill from there, with hilarious results. But, in the end, everyone is shown a deeper meaning to the Christmas Story; one that they had forgotten in the bustle of busyness. It makes a good book to read and it also makes a good movie to watch. The movie stars Loretta Swit (of M*A*S*H) who plays the part of the woman forced to run a Christmas Pageant perfectly. Both book and movie are classics and old favorites in my family.

This is a wonderful chapter book we read as a family (kids aged 13, 11, 6, 4, and 2) each Christmas.

It's only 7 chapters though they are fairly long. It tells the story of the horrible Herdman children and how they learn about the story of Christmas and help others feel the real spirit of the season by participating in the local church's Christmas pageant. We all find ourselves laughing out loud throughout the story and I (being Mom) always cry at the end though there is still plenty of laughs. Despite the use of the taking of the Lord's name in vain twice (by the Herdmans and immediately frowned upon by the others), I don't think there is another book so funny and enjoyable that teaches so many wonderful life lessons and brings in the real meaning of Christmas than *The Best Christmas Pageant Ever*.

I first read this book about 20 years ago when I read it aloud to my class of seventh grade students (I taught in a Church-run school). It is hilarious! I had to stop reading several times because the visual images it gave me were just too funny and I was laughing so hard I couldn't speak coherently. It is a memory I cherish. I was so glad to find a copy of it on . I read it again and the humor is still there. The story is told from the point-of-view of a young girl remembering a year her mother reluctantly took the responsibility for the church's children's Christmas program when a group of neighborhood brothers and sisters without much parental guidance, without soap, without manners manages to take over the main roles of the holy family. These kids just do not fit the traditional mold. Anyone who has worked with a children's church program has encountered their own "Herdman" kids and will nearly die with laughter. If you've never read it before (or seen the poorly made-for-tv movie version of it) this is fall-on-the-floor funny.

Ronan O'Connell the book takes place at the Herdman's house and the church. The book is about a Christmas pageant at the church. Herdman's are very bad kids who smoked and said bad words. The only reason that the Herdman's were even interested in church is because one of them heard that you get food there like chocolate cake but they do not get snacks at CCD the kid was just lying to sound cool to the Herdman's which did not work because the Herdman's wanted to join the church so they did then they were in the Christmas pageant and the problem was that all the kids and adults thought that they were going to ruin the Christmas pageant. But in the end they did not ruin it and it turned out to be okay. Overall I really liked the book and I would recommend it.

I read this entertaining book every year during the Christmas season. And, I never get tired of it. It's funny, but so poignant and heart warming also. Because of the Herdmans just discovering the story of the birth of Christ, you see the whole story through fresh eyes and it is quite an experience. Great
