Okay, so alien abduction isn't anything new. But Amanda Milo has developed a very interesting universe with much thought and a ton of originality. After reading way too many books through Kindle Unlimited, I have realized that many writers need an editor to help them out in writing a REAL novel of a decent length without being overly wordy without substance. This is a book that could get me so emotionally involved, I had to switch to another computer task just to get a breather. (It's very, VERY rare for me to experience this.) You really get to care about these characters even with life at the moment is always one danger after another. This is no two-hour read unless you are really good at speed reading. Speed reading isn't what I wanted to do. I wanted to read each and every word lest I miss something because there is a very good, believable progression of events with all sorts of surprises and twists. That's important in crafting a new and very different universe. Amanda Milo definitely took time in considering her universe, both the physical and the psychological aspects. It's one of the most believable novels that suspended my disbelief in over two hundred different reads. Though initially read via Kindle Unlimited, I quickly made it a permanent fixture to my Kindle library. I highly recommend you consider doing that, too. You won't regret it.
