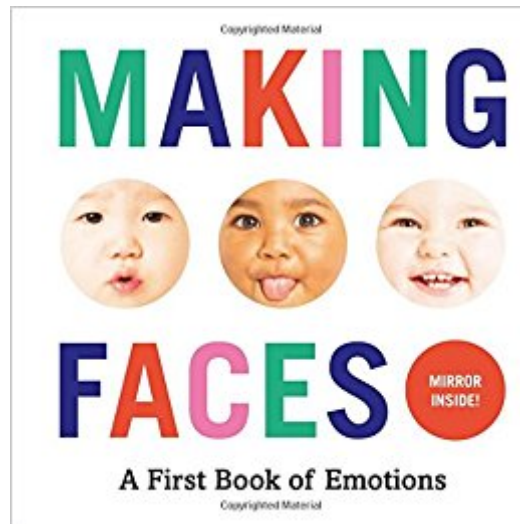

• happy, sad, angry, surprised and silly. The final page features a mirror in which you/your child can practice making faces. At 3, our daughter is really too old for Making Faces, but she loves it nonetheless. I don't know what it is about kids seeing pictures of other kids that make them so excited. This is another one that my husband reads with our daughter at night; in part because it's a fast primer when other book selections push us well past bedtime. I don't think we'll be reading it for too much longer, but I definitely recommend it for younger readers. We'll be passing our copy on to younger nieces/nephews when we outgrow it.\*I received an advanced reader copy from the publisher in exchange for my honest and unbiased review.

Making Faces: A First Book of Emotions is an adorable board book that teaches little ones how to recognize and understand different facial expressions. The use of real faces as the illustrations is a brilliant idea. It helps children identify how a person's face changes through emotions. The fun mirror at the end of the book allows babies to see how the emotional expressions they just learned from the story look on their own faces. They will also be entertained making faces of their own. I highly recommend picking up a copy of Making Faces: A First Book of Emotions.
