Joel is also the author of *Origami Games*, *Animated Origami Faces*, *Jewish Holiday Origami*, as well as *Washington Pops!*, a collection of do-it-yourself pop-up cards of famous buildings in Washington, D.C. His origami and pop-up creations have been exhibited in the U.S., Japan, and Israel.

First of all, it comes with a lot of paper, the paper seems to be good quality and there is a wide

variety of designs. However, this is not an easy kit due to poorly illustration instructions. The steps to be simple, but the instructions are impossible to follow for some of the basic folds that are needed for many of the projects. My 7 year old is intelligent, and I am intelligent, but we were unable to figure out how to do the Waterbomb Base which is the foundation for several of the latter projects. We ended up having to watch videos online, which made the process much easier than the instructions in the book. If you are willing to get some help online, it might be good for you. Maybe if you are a pro at assembling Ikea furniture based on those drawings you may find these instructions easy! We did not.

This would have easily been 5 stars if the stickers actually stuck to the paper, but they don't. As a kit for children, that ends up being a huge frustration and disappointment. The idea of stickers are what make this kit different and fun for kids. I thought maybe they were not staying stuck because the included paper is glossy, so we tried it with matte origami paper but it made no difference - the stickers just drop off after a few minutes. Other than the non-sticky stickers, the book has some great projects and the patterned paper is fun.

I have to say this was a great pack for Christmas. Kiddo is 7 years old (3 mths shy of 8) and is a very fidgety child. This set comes with great paper, a easy to do by himself instructions book, and even... wait for it.. stickers! To add eyes and stuff. Granted, after the first day the eyes ended up all over his room. If he had used them correctly, itd be great!Very easy to understand, easy to challenging options, comes with paper, comes with stickers. You just need a ziplock to store it all in. Awesome Buy!

My First Origami Kit is a nice collection of designs and paper, and the facial-feature stickers have been fun for my 6-year old granddaughter, however, I have two caveats for those who are considering this kit: 1) with my many years of origami experience, I didn't think the instructions for many of the figures were as good as I've seen everywhere else; I think they'd be frustrating to someone who wasn't familiar with origami. 2) Also, I think the suggested age range (6 and older) on the description is way too young. My granddaughter has fun watching me make the figures, but I find that she is too young to do anything herself. The package itself has no age range suggestion on it at all.

Both my daughters love this!!!The 6 year old needs help and I need to guide my 8 year old most of

the time. Fun for me too!

Bought this for my granddaughter for Christmas. She is 7 years old. She loved it. She began making figures right away. Directions are simple enough for her to follow. Her mom liked it too and began making her own figures. I would say that this is a good choice for children who are patient and enjoy doing craft items. Not for those with short attention span. Wish we could buy more paper and stickers.

My son has been wanting something like this for a while and I'm pleased. I have good reviews about this on ADHD blog.

Some too difficult for the age range they suggest. But fun project to do together
