

From bobcats to servals, small cats are spread across the globe. They range in size from the rusty-spotted cat and African black-footed cat, each of which weighs around 5 pounds when fully grown, to the Eurasian lynx, which can reach an adult weight of 60 pounds. These felids are elusive, some are nocturnal, others are arboreal, and all are rare and secretive, making them especially difficult to study. James G. Sanderson, the world's leading field expert on small wild cats, and naturalist and wildlife artist Patrick Watson provide informative and entertaining answers to common and unexpected questions about these animals. The authors explain why some small cats live on the ground while others inhabit trees, discuss the form and function of their coat types and colors, offer scientifically sound information on humanâs small wild cat interactions, and even review the role that small wild cats have played in literature, religion, and mythology. The world of cats is as fascinating as it is diverse. *Small Wild Cats: The Animal Answer Guide* shows just how important and interesting the littlest of the nondomesticated feline family are.

I'm a zoo docent and found this book fascinating since so many small cats aren't even available to see in zoos. It is written in a Q&A format which addresses all kinds of cat facts (how fast does a cat's heart beat?) common misperceptions (are cats pests?) and concerns that are as applicable to domestic cats (why do small cats get hit by cars) as they are to the ones in the wild. There are beautiful photos that drive home the point that we have to make room in our world for these beautiful creatures and even a chapter about cats in literature. The book would be appropriate for students of middle school age and up as well as the intended adult audience. If you are interested in cats from any perspective, you will love this book.
