

I'm enjoying the various stories of the artists in France- I like especially some of the notes about Picasso, he was apparently a trickster, putting on outfits with beards and so on to trick friends, funny. It's well written and informative, recommended.

What an inspiring book! It makes you want to become a more engaged traveler, who takes the time to discover the history and culture of a region. It's full of anecdotes, it's lively, and it gives you the perfect art history lesson, while taking you through 17 villages in French and Spanish Catalonia. You can feel the author's passion for the region. You'll walk in the footsteps of world-famous artists like Matisse, Picasso, and Dali and get to know them at the beginning of their careers, and see how the culture and people of Catalonia influenced their ideas and techniques. I especially loved finding out more about the local artists who befriended them and how together they helped each other become more authentic in their art work. A wonderful read!

Amazing amount of interesting information about the artists that visited or lived in Catalonia. Her writing made the stories of these famous artists come alive. The writing was vivid, I could see the landscape and hear the sounds she was describing.

I like the way the book is written and its fascinating to read about all the personal connections between the artists of that time and space. On the downside, the book is really short on images. The few pix included tend to be inadequate, small, monochrome and often not that relevant to the content of the pages they appear on. Disappointing, especially for a book on art and artists!

The two stars were for the writing which was fine but could not alone convey the subject of the book.

This book is a treasure! Written like fiction, but thoroughly researched, it has wide appeal. The author shares a peek into the personal lives of legends such as Matisse, Dali, and Picasso and the reader comes to understand why this region has inspired so many artists. An added bonus: the diaries of George-Daniel de Monfreid appear here for the first time in English.
