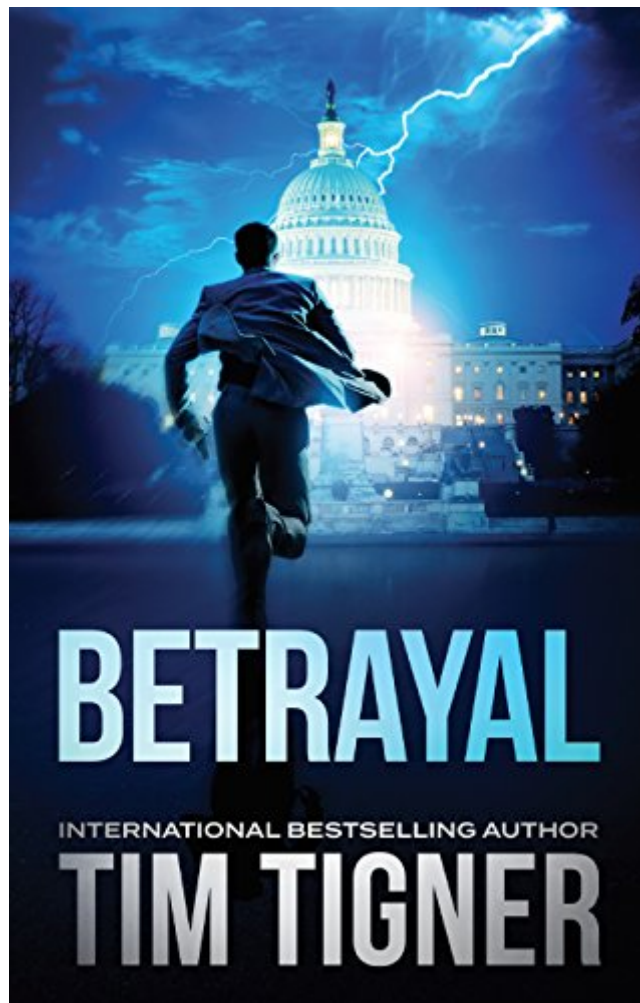

I wanted to get this review down while it is still fresh in my mind. I started it last night, read it until about 2 AM, woke up at 5 AM thinking about it, and started reading it again. I just could not quit reading it. This story is a very fast paced story and so suspenseful that it keeps you on the edge of your seat wondering what is going to happen next. Every time it looks as if the hero/heroine is about to have their life ended, something unexpectedly happens that saves them. There are many twists to this story. It is not a mystery, you know who all the bad guys are in the story except for one. The one I was not expecting to be a bad guy left me disappointed. What is so scary about this story is how most of this is very plausible-- and how easy it would be for a terrorist to infiltrate our country. As I mentioned to my husband, I hope no terrorist reads this book because it would give them too many ideas! One of the things that the story points out is how unprotected our borders really are. Another thing is how very political a war is, especially to interest groups that will either profit with money or with political promotions. The author's writing was so good I felt as if I were right in the story--I could visualize everything as it happened. I didn't notice any grammar errors or any other errors. This story is truly about betrayal, especially at the top. This is a stand alone story but I am looking forward to more stories about the main characters in this story and hope the author will write more about them. There was no foul language or explicit sex scenes in this story, which is so refreshing. Shows you that good stories can be told and hold your interests without sex and profanity. It is a little graphic at times but when terrorists are involved you expect this.

FBI Special Agent Odysseus "Odi" Carr, in addition to being a counter-terrorism, is an explosives specialist. His sister, Cassie, a behavioral psychiatrist, is in love with Odi's boss, the director of the FBI. This relationship leads to complications when Odi and his team are sent to attack what is supposed to be a terrorist training camp, and turns out to be a hospital. Odi's team is assassinated, and he barely escapes death himself. Meanwhile, back in the US, corporate fat cats, in an effort to protect their obscene profits, are behind acts of terror to keep the fear level

high. Their plans are working until they start dying, and realize that Odi didn't die, and he's now hunting them. The FBI director, part of the evil plot, sets Cassie against her own brother, and the race is on. Betrayal by Tim Tigner is a well-crafted thriller, and, while the Odi character is a bit larger than life, he's made manageable by having his twin sister, Cassie, as a counterpoint. Great escapist reading.

This is an exciting story; It is a story that could be real--right now. Betrayal is a perfect title, and the awful part of that is who are the betrayers. For me, it is how this kind of betrayal will happen. Maybe is happening. Right down from the top of our own government. I couldn't put this book down! I read it straight through. It is well written, well plotted, and darn well frightening due to the real possibility of those in the higher/highest echelons of our government selling out for power and money. I have become the ultimate skeptic. And, find more truth in fiction.

I could not put this book down! This is the first Tigner novel I have read and I can guarantee you it will not be the last. The Carr twins are steeped in intrigue and the fight against international terrorism. Brother and Sister Odi & Cassi are in separate branches in this fight. Why would every commando be killed while on a mission by the very department that sent them on the mission? Was the mission a false target? How did Odi survive? Who is (or perhaps, who are is a better choice of words) the betrayer...and why? How does a child care center figure into all of this? How can 24 planes...AND the QE II...be alerted in time to avoid a bigger terrorist disaster than 9/11? More importantly...What could happen that could turn Sister against Brother? And the most delicious part of the tale: how the betrayers end up paying for their treachery! What happens is...Forget it...I'm not spoiling this fantastic read for you. Pick it up, read it, and then you can say, "You know, this guy was spot on!"

The story is a little out there and a lot of improbable twists and characters (no spoilers here - sorry) BUT it's fiction- so why not? The best judge of a book to me is did it keep me reading? And this one did I enjoyed it and will read more by the same author..... if you're looking for a realistic book that makes you think this one might disappoint you but if you are just looking for a good story to kill a couple lazy afternoons---- this will work.

Look out Dirk Pitt, there's a new hero in town and his name is Odi . . .this was my 1st Tigner read and needless to say I'm now a groupie!!! I was hooked on the story, the characters, the writing style,

the pace, absolutely EVERYthing from the 2nd chapter, and would have read it in 1 sitting had I not started it @ 9:00 p.m. and needed to go to work in the morning! I won't provide details of the story, but let me just say if you crave a very well written, fast paced, modern day thriller, then get this book, I promise you will NOT be disappointed. And Tim, I hope you have future plans for Odi and Cassi . . .

This book was a great read! It was fast paced, well-written and believable. The characters were well-developed and either easy to sympathise with or to despise depending on their roll in the story. It is a long time since I have given a book 5 stars, but this deserves them. I am hoping this is or will be a series about the main characters. I would love to read more about Cassie and her brother, Odi.
