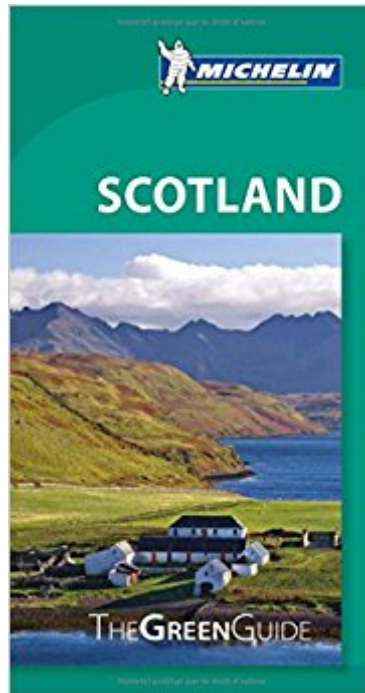




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# Michelin Green Guide Scotland (Green Guide/Michelin)

Before writing this review I checked my bookshelf: I have about a half-dozen green guides collected over more years than I'd like to consider. I always considered them to be excellent, one-size-fits-all, type of guides -- and the Scotland Guide is, on its own, very good. That's why we bought this one. It's just that with the internet, you can get more up-to-date information on your smart phone or tablet. Unlike the US, there are many, many free hotspots in Scotland so access is not that much of an issue. Truth is, we really didn't refer to it much at all. We did most of our research in the evenings for the following day's outings. At the castles or museums, there was enough posted or available information to make the guide redundant. However, it is useful for some maps and suggestions for self-guided tours. Of the printed guides, however, I would recommend this one over any other because of the way it is organized, the depth of detail and the convenient narrow size.

I have this guide published in 2000. I bought this updated version for new material. It's better organized than the 2000 edition. There are newer pictures.
