

Once again, Dr. Wiersbe provides new insights into Bible characters and stories. As with his first two "Be" series on the book of Genesis (*Be Basic* and *Be Obedient*), I found myself looking at the

first book of the Bible in a totally different way. This particular volume covers the stories of Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph. It reveals the character flaws of the patriarchs but also their "workable" hearts. If you're discouraged or despairing over your failures or dysfunctional behavior, be of good cheer and read this book. God has a purpose for you and even if you screw things up royally, He can still bring about His plans for your life. The keys are submission and trust. This is definitely a study I'll return to again and again for insight and encouragement.

The stories of Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph so clearly demonstrate that we are saved by grace and not by works. God loves us. That love is not dependent on what we do or don't do because We don't have to do to be loved. We are already loved. We will be eternally loved.
