

Strong) is a snapshot in time of the many beautifully decorated aircraft in storage at the boneyard, officially known as the 309th Aircraft Maintenance and Regeneration Group, Davis-Monthan AFB, Tucson, Arizona. This volume includes 300 images of aircraft decorated with nose art and other markings awaiting their final fate. In addition to his interest in aircraft storage and scrapping, Veronico has written more than two dozen other books on aviation and military subjects, local history, wreckchasing, and warbirds. He lives near San Francisco.

Here the two interests morph perfectly. The book shows modern (since the 1960s) American aircraft in storage in the Arizona desert "boneyard" at Davis-Monthan AFB at Tucson. Aircraft are sent there when surplus to military needs or outdated. Some wait to be recalled should need arise. Others wait to be scrapped. Eventually, that fate meets all the aircraft there. Items are stored in the markings they last served in. Authors of thus book have toured the site over the past decades with color and black & white film, capturing colors, military markings and squadron and individual pilots' "nose art" images before time and the smelting process delete them forever. Page after page of row upon row of aircraft that have defended this nation are featured. All military services are pictured. This book is just what the modeler of modern aircraft seeks, for one gets markings as well as hardware detail in the photos depicted. And ideas for modeling projects to boot! I recommend it.
