

The rhymes and illustrations are cute without being too cutesy, and the things the family is doing to prepare for Shabbat are things families actually do (make dinner, get cleaned up, set the table). It is a lovely celebration of the anticipation of Friday night, and I would definitely recommend it to other Jewish families.
