

Deeply unsettling, the facts and history laid out by David Cay Johnston evince the long history of a shady, greedy, and relentlessly sociopathic media mogul and his rise to power. From half-baked schemes, to false identities this book reads like a group of coiffed mob bosses sitting around a tacky gilded table trying to one-up each other with their stories. Except they're all Trump and they're all his stories and they're all true. This book will leave your jaw dropped as you have to repeatedly remind yourself THIS IS REAL.

This is the one I was waiting for! There's no flashing lights here, no cartoon versions of real people, no wallowing in moral outrage. Instead, it's got all the facts you need to explain to your pro-Trump friends (or that weird uncle at Thanksgiving- lol!) EXACTLY what's in Trump's record: and that's what makes him so dangerous. Full of good detail, with sources noted.

This is the third Trump biography which I have read. Although all three illustrate Trump's lack of honesty and character, this one is the most complete and detailed. It reveals Trump's connections to Mob members and other unsavory characters that are very disturbing.

If you're looking for a concise, compelling biography of Donald Trump, look no further. Rather than indulging in endless partisan rhetoric, Johnston just gives us the facts and they're spellbinding, and damning. This is the book for anyone even remotely curious as to who the Republican Party has nominated, and how he managed to get there.

This book is really exactly what I needed—a detailed investigation into Trump's past, his

business ventures, his relationships to other people, etc. Johnston writes a shocking and gripping account, without devolving into tabloid writing. It's smart, scrupulously researched, and truly a must-read for this election season.
