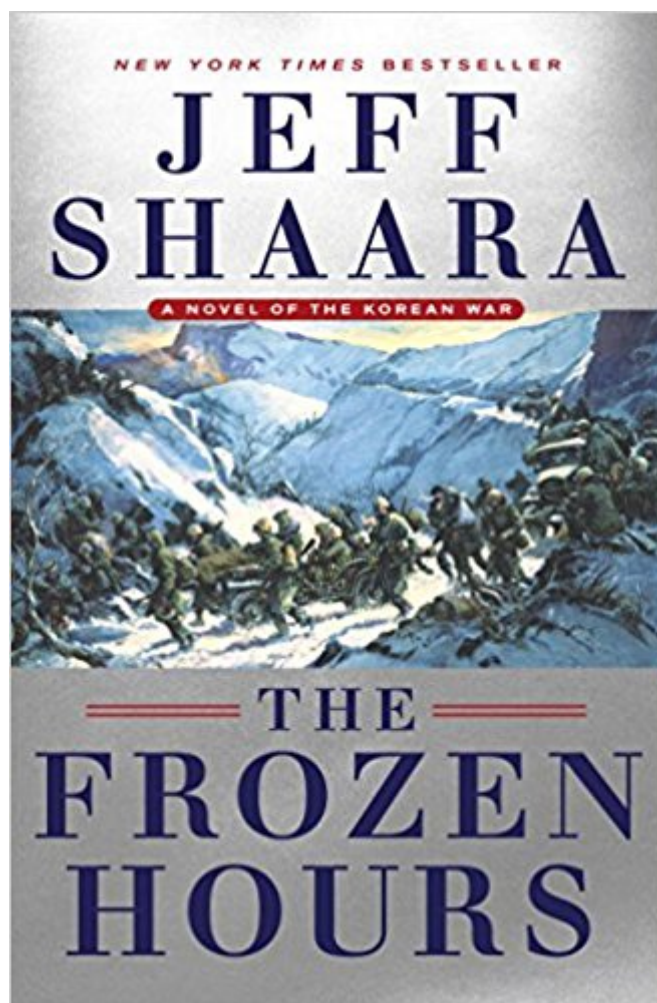

The Frozen Hours: A Novel Of The Korean War



Synopsis

June 1950. The North Korean army invades South Korea, intent on uniting the country under Communist rule. In response, the United States mobilizes a force to defend the overmatched South Korean troops, and together they drive the North Koreans back to their border with China. But several hundred thousand Chinese troops have entered Korea, laying massive traps for the Allies. In November 1950, the Chinese spring those traps. Allied forces, already battling stunningly cold weather, find themselves caught completely off guard as the Chinese advance around the Chosin Reservoir in North Korea. A force that once stood on the precipice of victory now finds itself on the brink of annihilation. Assured by General Douglas MacArthur that they would be home by Christmas, the soldiers and Marines fight for their lives against the most brutal weather conditions imaginable—and an enemy that outnumbers them more than six to one. The Frozen Hours tells the story of Frozen Chosin from multiple points of view: Oliver P. Smith, the commanding general of the American 1st Marine Division, who famously redefined retreat as “advancing in a different direction”; Marine Private Pete Riley, a World War II veteran who now faces the greatest fight of his life; and the Chinese commander Sung Shi-Lun, charged with destroying the Americans he has so completely surrounded, ever aware that above him, Chairman Mao Tse-Tung watches his every move. — Written with the propulsive force Shaara brings to all his novels of combat and courage, The Frozen Hours transports us to the critical moment in the history of America’s “Forgotten War,” when the fate of the Korean peninsula lay in the hands of a brave band of brothers battling both the elements and a determined, implacable foe. Jeff Shaara is the New York Times bestselling author of *The Fateful Lightning*, *The Smoke at Dawn*, *A Chain of Thunder*, *A Blaze of Glory*, *The Final Storm*, *No Less Than Victory*, *The Steel Wave*, *The Rising Tide*, *To the Last Man*, *The Glorious Cause*, *Rise to Rebellion*, and *Gone for Soldiers*, as well as *Gods and Generals* and *The Last Full Measure*—two novels that complete the Civil War trilogy that began with his father’s Pulitzer Prize-winning classic, *The Killer Angels*. Shaara was born into a family of Italian immigrants in New Brunswick, New Jersey. He grew up in Tallahassee, Florida, and graduated from Florida State University. He lives in Gettysburg.

I have read all of Jeff Shaara’s historical military fiction. *THE FROZEN HOURS* in my opinion ranks in the top two of my favorites, along with *GONE FOR SOLDIERS*, Shaara’s novel of the Mexican War. This is historically very accurate, and really makes this history of the “Forgotten War” come alive. This book definitely makes clear the dysfunction of marines fighting under army commanders who didn’t have a clue. Fortunately, the joint operations of present day operations are indeed better coordinated. But this incredible story of one of the coldest winters ever for US fighting men (even worse than the Argonne forest of WWII Battle of the Bulge) should be read by ALL of our current serving military who might have to follow in the snow prints of these incredible Korean War veterans. And Shaara is very skilled in describing the effects of the EXTREME cold on the infantry, the physicians, the medics, the engineers, and helicopter pilots and flight mechanics. I have talked to at least five triple veterans - WWII, Korea, and Vietnam during my early career as a military physician, and they ALL uniformly said that they didn’t think that they would “make it home” from Korea. This certainly could claim the prize as the best historical fiction of the Korean War ever. The story of Fox company and also Chesty Puller’s trip “down from the Chosin reservoir - completely surrounded, he is quoted as saying: “Great. Now we can shoot at those bastards from every direction.” This is a MUST READ for all military history buffs, and for everyone who had a father or uncle who served in Korea.

Considering the news of today, this timely and riveting tale of the Korean conflict is a must read for those who may have forgotten. Jeff Sharra is a master historian that not only brings the reader into actual events, but gives voice to those who suffer, endure, and live through battles. The conflict at the Chosin Reservoir should serve as a firm reminder and respect for those who survived this

horrid event.

Ok Summer reading. Somewhat repetitive like most of his novels. There is a lack of McArthur's insight, with Ten Corp being solely represented by clownish depiction of Gen. Almond. Lost is the godlike status of McArthur after Inchon. The Corps performance at Chosin is depicted in some detail. Although the explanation of why ammo is dropped but no rations screams out. The Chinese insight is dubious at best.
